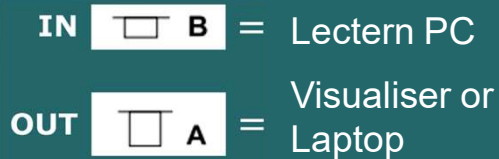


Power on



To power the system on using the remote control for the projector, point the remote towards the projector then press the 'On' button.

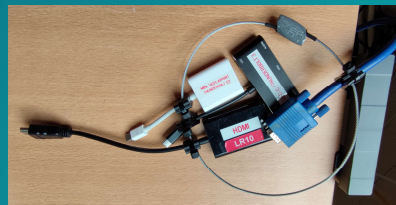
To change whether you have the PC projected or wish to use the Visualiser or a laptop, use the Kramer switch device on the lower shelf.



Connecting a laptop

Laptops and tablets can be connected using the VGA cable and required adaptor for your device. We have included a HDMI, Minidisplayport and USB-C adaptors to cover the majority of devices - simply connect the adaptor to the VGA cable, then the adaptor to your device.

Power off

For the projector, point the remote at the projector, press the 'Standby' button top left on the keypad then noting the message on the screen, press it a second time.
