To power the system on using the touchscreen controller on the lectern press the display lightly, select power on, then follow the on-screen prompts to power on the display screen(s) and select your source(s), as below:



Please ensure you power off the system when you have finished

Connecting a laptop

Laptops and tablets can be connected using either the HDMI or VGA input cables. Connect any adaptor you require to the input cable first then connect the adaptor to your device.

We have included USB-C and MiniDisplayport adaptors which work with most devices for your convenience.


Lectern PC - Windows & Linux
